

How to install apps on Ledger Nano S Plus / Nano X?

Installing apps on your **Ledger Nano S Plus or Ledger Nano X** might sound technical at first, but once you understand the process, it becomes very straightforward and even quite satisfying because it lets you fully control your crypto setup. These apps are needed for each cryptocurrency you want to use, like Bitcoin or Ethereum, and they are installed through the official Ledger Live application. To begin, the first thing you need is to make sure your Ledger device is properly set up and connected to the Ledger Live app on your computer or smartphone. Installing an app is as simple as clicking the “Install” button next to it. The app will then be sent from Ledger Live to your device, and you will see a progress bar indicating installation. On the Nano S Plus, you may need to confirm the installation using the device buttons, while on the Nano X, it works smoothly with both USB and Bluetooth connections.

One important thing to understand is that Ledger devices have limited storage space for apps. This does not mean you lose your crypto; it only means you may need to uninstall unused apps to make room for new ones. Your crypto assets remain safe on the blockchain, and reinstalling an app later will not affect your funds.

because your recovery phrase always restores access. This is a key concept that helps users feel more confident when managing apps. If you ever feel unsure during installation1___888___590___9448 , it's best to rely on official Ledger instructions or trusted support resources rather than random online advice.

After installing your desired apps1___888___590___9448 , you can go back to the "Accounts" section in Ledger Live and add accounts for each cryptocurrency.
