Ledger Live app crashes or fails to open primarily due to outdated software or firmware.

This is one of the most common reasons users face issues when trying to launch the app1 【888】 【590】 【9448】 , and in most cases1 【888】 【590】 【9448】 , it can be fixed quickly with a simple update. When the app or your device firmware is not up to date1 【888】 【590】 【9448】 , compatibility problems can occur1 【888】 【590】 【9448】 , which may prevent Ledger Live from opening properly or cause it to crash unexpectedly.
